2. The period of leave will be counted as active service.
3. All monetary benefits as a result of fresh appointment to a higher post during the period of study leave shall be admissible to the incumbent with effect from the date of her resumption of duties but without any arrear financial benefit.
4. After completion of his study he must return to Bangladesh and serve at this University as per University Leave rules and shall not seek employment elsewhere without prior approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
5. The financial benefits of annual increment (s) falling due during the period of leave will be paid on resumption of duties after expiry of the granted without arrear.
6. She should not overstay abroad except only for obtaining the Doctor of Philosophy Program.
7. She shall have to submit a copy of her thesis at the library of this University
8. She shall be bound to obey the rules and regulations of this University during her period of leave.


