In pursuance the above mentioned subject and reference that your study leave has been granted with full average pay for the period of 4 (four) years which effect from September 15, 2026 to September 14, 2030 to complete the PhD Program at The University of Queensland, Australia under the following terms and conditions.

4. She has submitted requisite bond according to University Leave Rules-2020 to serve in the relevant department of this university.
5. She will have to submit an annual progress report to this university which will be recommended by the head of department/research supervisor of the institution of study.
6. She must inform this university of her mailing address, fax number, and supervisor's address after arriving in Australia.

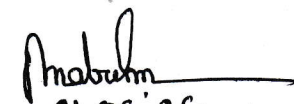
